

Gay and barred from God's Love !



We need your help...

Help support Chris and his partner Rodney. Ask Robin Adams, 'why and with what authority they have been barred?'

Chris is Gay and works for a well known international charity. His determination has taken thousands of Syrian Refugee children to safety. These are the actions of a Christian.

Chris lives near Redon and supports the establishment of an Anglican community in the town so when he learnt of Robin Adams arrival he wrote and introduced himself but he didn't expect to be told as a gay man that he is unhealthy and unnatural with a sickness that can be cured. As a Christian Chris believes he is gay because that is the way God made him.

Rodney lives in Paris and fled the intolerance in N Ireland during the years of the troubles. Intolerance that continues today. More recently Robin Adams has told Chris that being gay is a life-style choice. In the 21st Century we know that is dangerous nonsense.

When Chris was a young teenager he had to live through and survive the suicide of his boy friend which was caused by intolerance.

For years Chris hid his sexuality but now he is fully out he finds himself facing the same intolerance today that he risked all those years ago.

Ask Robin Adams...

1. With what authority have Chris and Rodney been barred. Has their exclusion been approved by the Bishop of Europe, the Rt. Revd. Robert Innes?
2. Two gay 14 year old boys, congregation members at Christ Church in Brittany, planned their suicide because they had no-one to turn to. Does Robin Adams know that the suicide rate of gay teenage boys is the highest in the Western World? Does he care?
3. Why is Robin Adams so hostile and unwelcoming to gay men? (More than 10 years ago Robin Adams took his Church in the USA, along with several others, out of the Anglican Communion, which had supported a welcome for gay men, and associated it with the Church in Nigeria hostile to the LGBT community). Ask Robin Adams if he supports the persecution, criminalisation, torture and execution of gay men in Nigeria?
4. In accusing Chris and his partner of being unnatural and unhealthy without having met them, he claimed to be speaking for the congregation. Has he asked the congregation?
5. Ask Robin Adams to justify his claim that homosexuality is a lifestyle choice.
6. Chris and Rodney have been praying that their rejection can be resolved. Will you pray with Chris and Rodney and Robin Adams for an acceptable reconciliation?
